On January 2007, while working on a remediation project, HEPACO encountered a piece of equipment contaminated by ethyl acryl ate. Ethyl acryl ate is an odorous material that leaves a strong residual scent on any substance it comes in contact with. During the decontamination efforts on the affected piece of equipment, HEPACO attempted to utilize many various solutions, but to no avail. However, it was found that E-Safe, a surfactant, was effective in the suppression of chemical odors on the metal portion of the equipment, but ineffective on rubber or PVC.
